2	Theme and Parameters for the Poster paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The theme for poster submission should be based on Cyber Crime Awareness and Investigation, Cyber Forensic Tools, Cyber Laws, Recent Cyber Frauds.Poster should include the after measures to be taken.Poster should include a maximum of 2-3 pages without plagiarism along with following guidelines-Title is short and draws interest.Word count of about 300 to 800 words.Text should be clear and to the point.Use bullets, numbering, and headlines to make it easy to read.Effective use of graphics, color and fonts.Consistent and clean layout.Includes acknowledgments, your name and institutional affiliation.
3	Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Maximum four students are allowed in a team.
4	Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none">There is NO REGISTRATION FEE for participating in the competition.One Team will submit only one Poster for the competition.Participants must Register and Submit their poster in the given portal:- https://forms.gle/MUa5gM4hybYQ5TFVAParticipants should mention the following in mail in bold letters:Name of the Student.Contact details including phone number.Poster attachment should be named as follows: Poster_Name of Student__The poster should focus on the theme and should have the theme written on the top front page of the poster.Participants should write their Name on the top or bottom right-hand corner of the poster.After submission of Poster, a Preliminary Screening of the Poster will be done as per the criteria given in the rules section mentioned below and best 5 students will be selected.After Preliminary Screening, selected students will have to make an Online Presentation for 2 minutes explaining their Poster.Online entries like Name, Surname and Contact Number should be entered correctly in the portal at the time of registration as the same will be used for generating certificates. Wrong entries can lead to discrepancy in the generation of certificate.
